

Is a Benzyl Benzoate lotion that is used for topical treatment of scabies and pediculosis (lice infestation) and also used as insect repellent.

- **Directions:**

**Scabies:** Apply the lotion on the whole body except the head and neck after a hot bath and drying well. Another lotion should be repeated without bathing on following day. Wash off 24 hours later.

**Pediculosis:** Apply to affected area for 24 hours. Then wash thoroughly.

**Insect Repellent:** Apply the application on the exposed area or the clothes, and to be washed within a period not exceeding 24 hours.

**Children:** Dilute with boiled then cooled water 1:1 ratio (12.5%)

**Infants:** Dilute with boiled then cooled water 2:1 ratio (8%)

- **Precautions:**

- Avoid the exposure of benzyl benzoate lotion to mucous membrane areas (nose, ear, mouth, lip and genital area).
- Don't apply Benzyl Benzoate lotion to broken or infected skin.
- Avoid repetitive use; repeated lotion of benzyl benzoate frequently causes contact dermatitis.
- Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines.

- **Contraindications:**

Do not use Benzyl Benzoate 25% Lotion If you are allergic to benzyl benzoate or any of the other ingredients of this medicine

- **Pregnancy and lactation:**

Tell your Doctor before taking Scabezyl Lotion.

- **In case of Overdose and accidental swallowing:**

If you experience uncontrolled shaking of body see your doctor or pharmacist or go to nearest emergency department. Treatment of poisoning involves aspiration and lavage and appropriate symptomatic measures.
